Plains Art Guides are volunteer docents who lead youth and adult tours of Plains Art Museum galleries. Plains Art Guides meet the second Monday of each month from 9:30-11:00 a.m. from October – May for behind-the-scenes tours with curators, interactive gallery-based learning sessions with education staff, and discussions about the work of the Museum. Each year the group takes a professional development day trip to an art institution in the region.
