LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

DEAR FRIENDS,



Growth materializes through nurturing and support, but it can also sometimes occur when something traumatic happens—for example, a pandemic or a personal crisis. For Plains Art Museum, fiscal year 2021 and 2022 (July 2020–June 2021), was a period of

intense and innovative growth reflected by a challenging environment and subsequent positive and responsive support.

The summer of 2020 started with a solo exhibition titled *She Gives* by the creative force Dyani White Hawk in her second museum solo exhibition. After her work appeared at Plains Art Museum, White Hawk exhibited at the Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art and was more recently included in the Whitney Biennial—one of the most prestigious exhibitions in the United States. Then, in the fall of 2020 we opened one of the most ambitious, and meaningful, group exhibitions Plains Art Museum has ever organized and presented. *High Visibility*, focused on contemporary art in rural spaces, portrayed intersecting layers of complex narratives by some of the country's preeminent artists working in rural spaces. These artists, such as Cannupa Hanska Luger, Jovan Speller, Karl Unnasch, and Raven Chacon pushed against overly simplistic portrayals of life in rural America.

Educational program growth took a giant leap in this period as well, with a renewed focus on community-based programming, youth intensives, and the creation of our 5 Plain Questions podcast. The podcast, produced by the Museum's Director of Indigenous Programs, Joe Williams (Sisseton Wahpeton Oyate), includes conversations with Indigenous creatives and other leaders. At the same time, as we reopened after closure in June of 2020, we increased our safety protocols and reintroduced virtual and eventually in-person classes in our

Katherine Kilbourne Burgum Center for Creativity. Building on our programmatic diversification, we also created a new initiative called Voices of Creative Change, an educational and curatorial initiative designed to further diversify the Museum's programming and collaborative capacity.

In 2021, growth in the Museum continued through the acquisition of a major collection of artworks by Steven M. Andersen, including a suite of prints by Sam Gilliam and many other noteworthy works. We also began to collect artworks that reflected creative responses to the pandemic, placing a firmer hold on the Museum's value of providing space for challenging discussion and reflection.

The evolution of the Museum extended into 2022 as we exhibited the culmination of years of planning with regionally-based Latinx artist group Grupo Soap del Corazón. This project was both heavy and light—full of love and humor as well as sharp critical commentary. The exhibition, which was titled *La Línea*, also included a series of works that ended up serving as a memorial to legendary artist Jim Denomie.

The combination of new initiatives and an ambitious and knowledgeable staff, has driven our current mission engagement to grow to over 50,000 people per year. When you support your Plains Art Museum, not only are you supporting our growth, but also you nurture creativity, foster problem-solving skills, and cultivate empathy and build community. For those of you that have supported Plains Art Museum through this time, we cannot thank you enough. You make everything possible.

SELECT PROGRAMS, PROJECTS & INITIATIVES

PLAINS ART CASES

The Museum's Art Case program is designed to provide art education resources to classrooms in our region that have little or no formal art education in place. Each case is packed with a miniature exhibition of works by regional artists and comes with an education guide that encourages classroom participation. The cases are loaned for free and educators pay no shipping fees.

SCHOOL SPIRIT: YOUTH ART MONTH

In March, the Museum showcases the talents of Kindergarten through 12th grade art students from more than 40 schools to increase community awareness of regional arts programs and emphasize the value of the arts and self expression. The Museum also hosts an artists' reception for young area artists and their families, an exciting gathering of about 1,100 people that includes performances from the Fargo Moorhead Area Youth Symphonies and art-making activities.

KID QUEST

Kid Quest is a free, family program, held the first Saturday of the month from October through April. The event draws around 200 children and family members each month, offering them the opportunity to explore art in the galleries and then participate in creating an art project together at the Katherine Kilbourne Burgum Center for Creativity. Xcel Energy is the primary sponsor, with additional support from Minnesota Public Radio.

CREATIVITY AMONG NATIVE AMERICAN ARTISTS INITIATIVE

Creativity Among Native American Artists involves Native American artists in programs and exhibitions at Plains Art Museum. It provides a Native American artist in residence program, engaging exhibitions, and multiple learning opportunities through workshops, artist talks, and professional development.

5 PLAIN QUESTIONS

5 Plain Questions is a podcast that poses 5 general questions to Indigenous artists, creators, musicians, writers, movers and shakers, and culture bearers. 5 Plain Questions is produced by Plains Art Museum and edited by Eleven Warrior Arts LLC. STUDIO CLASSES

Art-making classes for youth and adults offer opportunities for inquisitive people of all ages. Classes are held at the Katherine Kilbourne Burgum Center for Creativity, a multipurpose arts facility that also offers studio and exhibition space for learning, discussion, and display of creative work. Plains Art Museum's studio programs focus on developing people's potential for deeper learning and problem solving through 21st-century skills: creativity, collaboration, critical thinking, and communication. The Bradley J. Burgum skybridge connects the original museum building with this 25,500 square foot expansion.

OPEN STUDIO

Members are invited to work on ceramic projects during Open Studio hours offered four days a week in the Katherine Kilbourne Burgum Center for Creativity, in an atmosphere where people can come together to work on projects—experimenting, collaborating, and encouraging fellow artists.

TUESDAYS FOR TODDLERS

A time for our youngest visitors and their grown-ups to foster creativity and imagination through stories, songs, and hands-on art activities. Each month we will offer a unique theme and a new art project for the child to create and take home. Recommended for children ages 2-5. Siblings, younger than two, can accompany the group for free.

VOICES OF CREATIVE CHANGE INITIATIVE

The Voices of Creative Change Initiative | Fugitive Laboratory for Ideas and Creativity (VCCI | FLIC) emerges as an essential component in Plains Art Museum's educational, curatorial, and administrative teams. The purpose is to develop and manage dynamic and community-responsive programming at Plains Art Museum. VCCI-FLIC also generates an emerging set of experimental and conceptual artistic programs and projects that are designed to recognize, highlight, and elevate diverse artists' voices, build trust between the Museum and vulnerable communities, and advance the Museum's Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Accessibility (I.D.E.A.) motivations.



SELECT PROGRAMS, PROJECTS & INITIATIVES

ART + AUTISM WORKSHOPS

All sessions are developed and instructed by Plains Art Museum Education Staff and Special Education professionals for families with children on the Autism Spectrum Disorder.

ART & BUSINESS BRUNCH

This innovative program brings together Fargo-Moorhead-West Fargo business and cultural leaders. Through presentations, conversations, and activities, we explore shared connections and the potential for discovering, engaging, and expanding mutually beneficial relationships.

LOW-SENSORY MONDAYS

We embrace the unique qualities of all who walk through our doors and appreciate that many visitors need to explore the Museum in different ways. For individuals and families who prefer a quiet, less sensory-stimulating environment we offer Low-Sensory Mondays on the first Monday afternoon of every month. At each event, loud gallery sounds and bright lights are turned down and attendance is limited.

HANNAHER'S INC. PRINT STUDIO

This space is designed as a place to explore the art of printmaking in all its various forms. The Museum is one of only a handful in the nation with a fully functional print studio.

THE GOLDBERG ART LOUNGE

In this hands-on learning space for all ages, visitors have the opportunity to learn in a relaxed environment through art activities, games, books.

CERAMIC POP-UP

This event features ceramicists from all over the country in two-week long virtual auction. Proceeds benefit PlainsArt4All, keeping the Museum general admission free, enabling arts access for all.

PROGRESSIVE ARCHITECTURE DINNER

Guests are invited to tour up to four architecturally unique homes in Fargo-Moorhead and its surrounding region. Each house features a different dinner course. Proceeds benefit the Museum's PlainsArt4All initiative, keeping the Museum general admission free, enabling arts access for all.

HERITAGE GARDEN & AMPHITHEATER

Designed by artists Su Legatt, Rob Fischer, and Kevin Johnson, the Heritage Garden & Amphitheater is located near the site of the decommissioned power plant along the Red River and adjacent to Woodlawn Park. The power plant provided power to Moorhead from 1896 until 2014, and was a central element to the Woodlawn Park neighborhood. The artists' plan has created an environment that serves as an homage to the power plant, the history of the neighborhood and its residents. Elements from the power plant are incorporated into landforms and garden beds, and serve as found sculptures. Residents from the neighborhood have contributed plants and their personal stories.

BUZZ LAB

Buzz Lab teen interns spent a week in June studying pollinators, tending to the Pollinator Garden at Plains Art Museum, and educating the community on the vital role pollinators play in our ecosystem.

ANNUAL SPRING GALA

Held annually on the first Saturday of May, the Museum's largest fundraiser raises money its education programs. It features live music, hors d'oeuvres, as well as the area's largest wine tasting and art auction.

VISIT US VIRTUALLY

Plains Art Museum is sharing a series of virtual programs and resources for all ages! From live virtual classes to mindfulness exercises, art-making and art appreciation offer healthy modes of stress release. Generous support for these projects was provided by Art Bridges.
